

INTRODUCING FORUMS

Unconventional Business Network is delighted to introduce **Forums**. These business leader groups are designed for businessmen and women, regardless of their role. Meeting monthly, typically during an extended breakfast or lunch period, members develop meaningful relationships during the informal networking time and take part in exclusive faith + work video training. A guided group discussion and closing prayer time close out each session. To round out the Forum experience, look for additional member benefits coming soon. You don't want to miss this opportunity to grow with others on this Faith + Work journey!

TYPICAL FORUM QUESTIONS

- Who joins Forum groups? Christian businesspeople from all ethnicities, age groups and industries—especially those representing small businesses with 100 or fewer employees. They can be small business owners, managers, team leaders or employees—business professionals who want to grow in integrating their faith in their workplaces.
- When are Forum groups starting? Groups are forming now with April, May and June start dates.
- Will the groups meet virtually or in-person? at night, over lunch, or early morning? Any of these scenarios are possible. It depends upon the group, its leadership and current COVID guidelines.
- Where will future in-person groups meet? Forum groups can meet anywhere there are audio-visual capabilities, room for 10 to 30 attendees and vetted leadership. (See "Interested in Leading a UB Forum group?" that follows.)
- How much does it cost to join a Forum group? Members joining a Forum group in 2021 will have "Founder" status and pay \$29.95 a month, or an annual discounted fee of \$300. As they become available, Founding Members will have access to newly launching member benefits like our network directory, online faith + work library and virtual networking/workshop platform—just to name a few.
- How do I know if a Forum is right for me? Forum groups are ideal for businesspeople who want encouragement, inspiration, wisdom and accountability. Ideally, you will get to know your fellow Forum members well. Think of a small group at your church: doing life together, only with a focus on business and an eye towards what God's Word says about marketplace leadership. Forum members are serious about their faith + work journey and want to change lives and impact their workplaces and communities for Christ.
- Is there homework or advanced preparation? No. There is the 20-minute video presentation and a leader led discussion. However, there is an "optional" going deeper section that members can complete on their own.
