Discussion Questions

1. What stood out the most to you in this video?

2. The approach the Kendrick brothers take to producing their films is not asking what the world wants to hear and adding Jesus to it, but rather starting with prayer and seeing what God wants them to produce first. How is this approach counter-cultural, and how is this approach similar or different to how you do business?

3. Jeremiah 29:13 says, "If you seek me, you will find me if you seek me with your whole heart". Can anyone share an example in business, where you have had to fall on your face like Alex did and seek God with your whole heart?

4. Hebrews 11:6 says, "Without faith, it is impossible to please God". Modern business culture emphasizes self-reliance, strategic planning, and data-driven decision-making. Seeking God first is not only counter-cultural, but it contradicts the modern-day mindset of doing business. How can Christian Business Leaders do business unconventionally and please God first before trying to take matters into their own hands? Give some examples.

5. Peter 3:15 says, "But in your hearts, set apart Christ as Lord. Always be ready to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect". As Christian business leaders, how do we do this well so we can continue honoring God in all we do without compromising our witness and still be successful in business?

Share with the group what you are willing to do differently as you strive to take counter-cultural stands for Christ in what you do. Not to make this more uncomfortable than it already is, but if you put nothing down, you will probably do nothing differently.
